## Baseball Field

The baseball field, roughly 2 acres ( 0.8 hectares) in area, is divided into an infield and outfield. The infield includes the bases and the pitcher's mound, ending at the arced edge of the dirt. Each base in the infield is separated from the next by $90 \mathrm{ft}(27 \mathrm{~m})$, and the pitcher stands $60.5 \mathrm{ft}(18.4 \mathrm{~m})$ from home plate. The outfield stretches beyond the infield dirt.
